Our Flag, contains an American Flag, red sashes for girls & adults, caller's commands for a flag ceremony and a notebook full of different flag ceremonies!

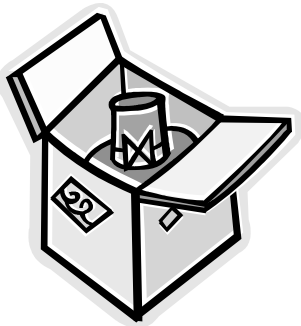

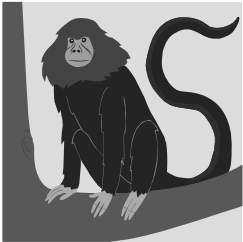

Each tour program contains pre-visit activities and post visit activities to enhance what the girls learn at the zoo. Also included are teacher and chaperone background information and a map of the self guided trail.
